DEAR FELLOW **ANIMAL LOVER**

A MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT ANTHONY TANSIMORE

To me, this year is passing by at the speed of light. We had a busy summer filled with hundreds of young kittens in our Kitten Nursery, orphaned baby wild animals in our Wildlife Care Center, helping animals find their forever families, and a fun-filled afternoon at our Bark n' Brewfest event. Meanwhile, daily life at the shelter continued with our low-cost Spay/Neuter Clinic, animal feeding, medical care, and offerings of playtime and love for our shelter animals! All of which prepares them to be adopted into loving homes. Thanks to you, we are able to do this work!

In July, we partnered with the County of San Mateo and Supervisor David Canepa for a "Loneliness to Light" presentation on how pets help fight loneliness. A survey by the county found that about 45% of residents reported difficulties with social isolation and loneliness! The psychologist and animal experts who spoke relayed that animal companionship can help address health issues caused by loneliness including alleviating stress, improving heart rate and blood pressure, and encouraging physical activity.

PHS/SPCA's Pet Assisted Therapy dogs Cooper, Buster, and Oliver also made an appearance at the Loneliness to Light presentation. They are VERY experienced in providing comfort, support, and relief to individuals with physical, emotional, or mental health conditions. Our Pet Assisted Therapy teams are made up of local residents who volunteer with their pets to visit healthcare facilities, schools, libraries, drug rehabilitation centers, and correctional facilities.

I know that I could never thank my dog Zoey enough for all she does to uplift my spirits and bring joy to my neighbors and me. I understand completely the positive impact of animal companionship and the way animals help us feel more connected. In addition to getting me out in the fresh air for regular walks, Zoey also connects me to my neighbors. We regularly attend "Yappy Hour" where I live. It is so easy to strike up a conversation with strangers when animals are present!

Speaking of connecting to our community, I hope to see you at our signature event, A Home for the Holidays Gala! This is one of my favorite events of the year because I love spending the evening socializing with and thanking the supporters of our life-saving work. The food and music are excellent, but the real stars of the evening are the adorable shelter animals you'll meet at the event! PET FOOD BANK SERVES ONE MILLIONTH MEAL

KEEPING FAMILIES TOGETHER WITH THEIR PETS

At the heart of every thriving community are initiatives that extend a helping hand to those in need. For us, this means programs that support pets and their owners as well as helping unwanted, injured, and stray animals. That's why we provide a variety of easily accessible and affordable services such as our low-cost Spay/Neuter Clinic and low-cost Vaccination Clinic. Our dog training classes, free behavior consultation helpline, and one-on-one behavior consultations help modify pet behaviors that owners find challenging, and this helps pets and their families live together happily!

One program that continues to tangibly impact the lives of hundreds of pets and their families is our Pet Food Bank. We offer this service to residents of San Mateo County who are facing financial hardship by providing monthly food and supply pickups. It is a vital resource for over 500 registered pets.

Earlier this year, we served our one millionth meal since the program started in 2020! The demand for our Pet Food Bank is higher than ever and we now have a waitlist to join. If you'd like to support the Pet Food Bank, read on!

The Pet Food Bank needs these items new and unopened:

- Bags of dog and cat kibble (all sizes)
- Canned dog and cat food
- Clumping and non-clumping litter

Donations may be dropped off at 1450 Rollins Road in Burlingame between 11 a.m. and 6 p.m. every day. We are unable to accept food that is expired, opened, prescription (Rx), or needs to be refrigerated or frozen.

The Pet Food Bank is 100% donor funded. Monetary donations allow us to buy food in bulk. The gratitude expressed by those receiving food for their beloved pets is truly moving. Thanks to all who support this wonderful program that helps keep pets with their families! ■

**CHARLIE FINDS HIS FOREVER FAMILY
AFTER 380 DAYS IN THE SHELTER!**

Charlie came to us as a stray at the beginning of summer back in 2023. After over a year in our care, this adorable guy finally found his forever home. His story is a testament to the impact patience, dedication, consistency, and love have on an animal.

Charlie arrived at our shelter in need of socialization, manners, and leash etiquette. This very strong and easily excitable guy was often jumpy and pulled HARD on his leash during walks.

After months and months of following our behavior staff's tailored behavior modification plan, Charlie went from being unsure about walks to patiently waiting, sitting when asked, and calmly allowing his leash and harness to be put on.

During his stay with us, Charlie became a Shelter K9 NoseWork graduate. In this class, dogs receive mental stimulation and exercise by learning how to search in boxes and around various objects for tasty treats.

Next, Charlie started working toward his Canine Good Citizen certification. This is a training we provide some of our dogs while they are here at the shelter. He focused diligently to learn skills such as politely greeting strangers, exhibiting good manners on walks, and obeying basic commands. He kept his enthusiasm, and this regular training helped him become calmer and prepared him to become part of a family!

We are so proud of the progress he made and are thrilled to report that after 380 days in our care, Charlie found his forever home. We all miss his love, energy, and joy but are so happy he found his forever family to share his life with. ■

“LIFE IS GREAT. CHEESE MAKES IT BETTER”

Visitors often enter our shelter anticipating dogs and cats available for adoption. Many are surprised when they learn that we also have lizards, birds, turtles, Guinea pigs, snakes, hamsters, rabbits, fish, and more!

In December last year, we were shocked when 25 rabbits were dropped off in our after-hours kennels late in the evening at our intake shelter in San Mateo. We do, at times, receive groups of rabbits, but never can we remember this many! The details were scarce, but we think they may have all come from one mating pair. Many pet owners become surprised at just how rapidly two non-spayed/neutered rabbits multiply and become more than they can manage.

Whatever their history, to us this group of 25 was connected through their joint late-night arrival to our shelter. An inspired staff member named this fluffie of rabbits after cheeses such as Mozzarella, Gorgonzola, Cheesecake, Ricotta, and Asiago. Each rabbit was examined by veterinary staff, treated for various medical issues, and – importantly – spayed or neutered.

Since December many of these rabbits have found their forever families, including Cotija, Asiago, Fontina, Feta, Queso, Cheez, Whiz, Mascarpone, Parmesan, and bonded pair Blue and Brie.

We are able to provide care for animals like this because of your support of our donor-funded Hope Program. As an open-door shelter, we accept all animals regardless of their age, size, or species. For some of them, our shelter is their only chance. The Hope Program enables us to go the extra mile for those who need it, and saves over 150 animals every month, thanks to your generous support!

As of press time, Monterey, Pepperjack, Gouda, Jack, Cheddar, Burrata, Colby, and other rabbits are still looking for their forever homes!

Rabbits make excellent pets. They are full of

character and personality. They often form strong bonds with their owners and can be affectionate and comforting. They are highly intelligent and can learn commands and tricks, such as fetching objects, jumping through hoops, and playing games. ■

SHERIFF AND FIRE DEPARTMENT TO THE RESCUE

NOT ALL HEROES WEAR CAPES!

One sunny day in Millbrae, a young kitten became a little too curious about what was under the street he was meandering on. He went exploring down a storm drain, then found himself stuck. A passerby heard some troubled meows coming up through the street grate and called first responders for help.

Shortly thereafter, some local heroes from the San Mateo County Sheriff's Department and Central County Fire navigated down into the 20-foot storm drain and rescued the kitten.

The first responders brought the rescued kitten to our shelter. Our veterinary staff examined him and saw that he needed to be treated for ringworm, a fungal skin infection that can cause areas of hair loss and scabbing. Because ringworm is contagious to humans and other animals, the kitten was kept in an isolated, easy-to-clean area. He was regularly treated with lime-sulfur dips and an oral medication. After a couple months of treatment, he was healthy, neutered, and ready for adoption!

This little kitten's rescue was quite popular on our Instagram page (@peninsulahumanesociety). When it was time to give him a name, we had a naming contest for this adorable guy. The winning name was "Sheriff"!

In a storybook ending, Sheriff found his forever family and they are all living happily ever after! ■

REUNITING BABY FALCONS AND THEIR FAMILIES

TWO RESCUES IN ONE WEEK!

In a rare occurrence this past summer, two pre-fledgling peregrine falcons, called eyas, fell out of their nests in separate incidents in different cities during the same week! Both were brought to us for medical examination and care.

The first falcon we cared for was a baby member of the much-loved “San Jose City Hall Falcon Family” who accidentally fell from its nest. Local community members who track the family reported it was baby Lucia. She was rescued from a City Hall building alcove by a UC Santa Cruz biologist and brought to us for a medical examination. Our wildlife staff examined her and found no injuries. Once she was medically cleared to be released, we worked with the biologists to reunite Lucia with her family.

The second pre-fledgling peregrine falcon fell from its nest near San Mateo. Again, a biologist brought the falcon to us for medical examination. The bird was found to be dehydrated and fluids were administered. Once stabilized, the eya was released to UC Santa Cruz biologists who worked with Caltrans staff to reunite the baby falcon with its family in a nest 100 feet above the ground!

These babies caught a case of spring fever and tried to flee the nest a little early! We are thrilled that both are healthy and have been reunited with their families.

CREATING A MORE COMPASSIONATE FUTURE

Animal Camp is one of our most beloved educational programs. Each summer we offer intensive week-long learning experiences for youth ages 8-10 and 11-13. Our education staff and volunteers facilitate seven weeks of Animal Camp for a total of 150 youth. This year, we partnered with LifeMoves in San Mateo to offer a free animal camp for youth in low-income families. Our camps aim to foster understanding and compassion for animals. They are also a lot of fun!

The children love partaking in opportunities to meet and learn about many types of pets including rabbits, Guinea pigs, snakes, lizards, jumping spiders, chickens, pigeons, dogs, cats, and more! They learned how to interact with and care for animals as well as the basics of animal husbandry and how to read dog, cat, and rabbit body language. Campers have the opportunity to practice dog training, play games, make enrichment toys for shelter animals, and learn about welfare issues that impact animals locally and globally, such as factory farming and the exotic pet trade.

Educational programs like our Animal Camp help to create more compassionate future generations, which benefits us all, not just the animals! ■
