As we prepared for summer here at the shelter anticipating a full house of wildlife and domestic animals, I was reminded of so many details that go into looking after the animals in our care. I know how much time and attention I put into caring for my dog Zoey each day! Imagine that multiplied by the hundreds! I am always full of gratitude for our staff, volunteers, and supporters when I think about just how much care is provided to our shelter animals and wildlife each day.

From the expert veterinary attention they receive to the cleaning of their kennels, hundreds of actions are taken every day to make sure they thrive. Placing fresh supplies of hay in the rabbit cages, syringe feeding orphaned wildlife, refilling water dishes for the dogs and walking them, feeding baby kittens so young that they have yet to open their eyes — these are just a few of the things our staff and volunteers do each day. And our adoptions staff works tirelessly to match the animals with their perfect forever families. Many adopters and their new pets come back and take part in dog playgroups and training classes run by our skilled behavior staff.

Thanks to you, we have been able to expand this work over the years and care for animals in new, innovative ways. This year, we will celebrate our 75th birthday since our founding in 1950! 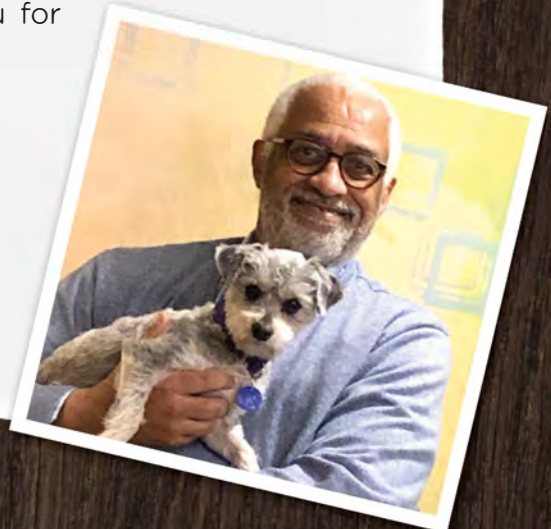

Protecting Your Pet

DURING HOT WEATHER

Help protect the health of pets during summer heat by taking these steps.

- ✓ Exercise pets early in the morning or late in the evening when temperatures are cooler.
- ✓ Bring water and take breaks in the shade when walking.
- ✓ Bring pets inside during periods of extreme heat.
- ✓ Avoid leaving pets in cars.
- ✓ Ensure pets have plenty of shade and shelter if outside. Remember, the shade pets have in the morning will either change or diminish as the sun moves throughout the day and may not protect them.
- ✓ Asphalt and concrete can get very hot and cause severe burns on the pads of your pet's feet. Consider using protective booties to place over their feet or walking them on grass. If it is too hot for you to rest your hand on the ground, it is too hot for your pet's paws.

Remember not to leave your pet in the car unattended. Even a comfortable 75 degrees outside can reach over 100 degrees in minutes inside a parked car.

WILDLIFE CARE CENTER IS OPEN FOR PATIENTS!

SARATOGA SITE TEEMING WITH NEW WILDLIFE

PHS/SPCA treats injured, sick, or orphaned wildlife from San Francisco, San Mateo, and Santa Clara counties. Here are a few Bay Area wildlife species that made their way to the Wildlife Care Center recently.

Great Horned Owlets

In late March, a great horned owlet was admitted from Los Gatos after falling from a high tree nest. A week later, a second orphaned owlet was admitted from Hillsborough. A few days later, the Hillsborough owlet's sibling was found on the ground orphaned. All three will be raised together until the end of summer while they learn their owl behaviors so they can survive in the wild.



Gray Foxes

In April, six gray fox kits were discovered alone on a construction site in the Alum Rock Park area of San Jose. While working with the Alum Rock Park rangers, the construction crew tried to reunite the kits with their mother but were unsuccessful. We will raise these young gray foxes together until early October, when they will be returned to the wild.



Screech Owl

An adult western screech owl that collided with a vehicle suffered head trauma. We provided the owl with aggressive, supportive care for the injury. The owl responded very well to treatment and was released back to the wild to fly free once again!



Acorn Woodpecker

The Wildlife Care Center in Saratoga raised this acorn woodpecker as a hatchling. The hatchling came to us due to a tree trimming accident. The bird was in our care for over two months. What is amazing is that the bird was placed in an aviary right across from a wild family of acorn woodpeckers so it could become familiar with their vocalizations. When released the bird was accepted right into the "clan."

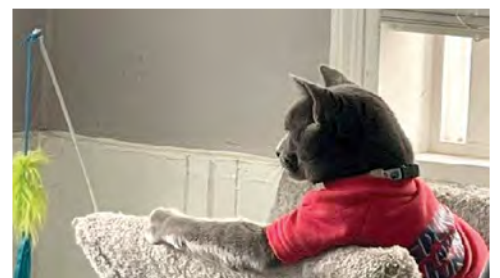

"We love **ODIN** - he is so smart! He has settled in nicely. Thank you for all the help."

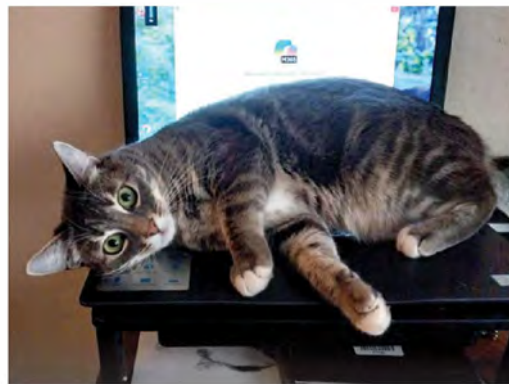


"**LOLA** likes to sleep under the covers. It is so cute in the morning when her little pink nose peeks out from underneath the blanket!"

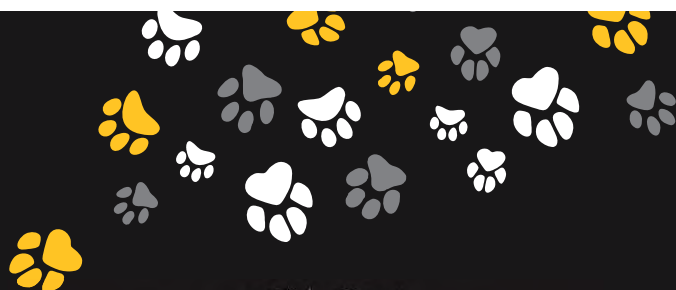
